

Create your own Remembrance Day Poppys



Items Needed:

Red tissue paper Pen or pencil Plain card/paper Green pipe cleaner/card Glue

Black felt tip/button or sticker for the centre of the poppy.

Method:

Cut a circle out of card/paper to use as a template to stick your petals onto. If using tissue paper, take it out the packet but do not unravel it. Keep it folded up and draw a large petal shape and a smaller size petal shape onto the tissue paper. Then once you cut the petal shape out you will have multiple petals for your poppy.

Glue 4 large petals onto your circular template and then glue 4 small petals on top od the large petals. Scrunch the petals slightly to make them look like they have been blowing in the wind.

For the centre of the poppy if you do not have stickers either colour in the centre using a black felt tip pen. Or, cut out a small circle colour it in black and stick it on like above.

Now for the leaf – if you are using a pipe cleaner fold it in half and in half again and mould it around on itself until you get the desired size/look for your poppy leaf. If you are using green card/paper, then draw a leaf shape and cut out. Glue the leaf onto the back of the template and you are done!!!

There you have it your very own Remembrance Day Poppy!
