Make Your Own Bingo

Materials Needed:

- · Ping pong balls or small paper balls
- Marker pen
- Crumpled paper or small pieces of card (for numbers)
- A large bowl or box (for drawing the balls)
- Pen and paper (for Bingo cards)

How to Make Your Bingo Game:

1. Create Bingo Balls

- Number your ping pong balls from 1 to 75 (or 1 to 90 if you want a full game).
- Use a marker pen to write the numbers directly onto the balls.
- No ping pong balls? Use small pieces of paper or foil-wrapped paper balls instead, numbering each one.

2. Prepare a Drawing Bowl

 Place all numbered balls or paper pieces into a large bowl or box to act as your drawing container.

3. Make Bingo Cards

- $_{\circ}$ Draw a 5x5 grid on paper for each player.
- Fill each space with a random number between 1 and 75 (or 90), making sure there are no duplicates.
- Mark the centre square as a free space, if desired.

4. Play the Game

- Choose a "caller" to draw balls from the bowl and announce the numbers.
- Players mark off numbers on their Bingo cards as they are called.
- The first player to complete a row, column, or diagonal shouts "Bingo!" and wins.
