



How to Make a Knitted Pom Pom Using a Pom Pom Maker

Follow these easy step-by-step instructions to create a fluffy, knitted pom pom using a pom pom maker.

You Will Need:

- A pom pom maker
- Wool or yarn of your choice
- Scissors



Step-by-Step Instructions:

1. Open the Pom Pom Maker

- Your pom pom maker will have two semi-circle arms on each side.
- Open both arms outwards so they are fully extended.

2. Wrap the Yarn Around One Side

- Take your wool and start wrapping it evenly around one side of the pom pom maker.
- Keep wrapping until you have a thick layer (the more yarn you use, the fluffier the pom pom will be).

3. Repeat on the Other Side

- Once one side is full, cut the yarn and move to the other half of the pom pom maker.
- Wrap the yarn in the same way, ensuring both sides have an equal amount of wool.

4. Close the Pom Pom Maker

- Fold both sides of the pom pom maker back into the centre so they meet together.

5. Cut the Yarn

- Using sharp scissors, carefully cut along the middle groove of the pom pom maker on both sides.
- Hold the pom pom maker firmly while cutting to keep the yarn in place.

6. Secure the Pom Pom

- Cut a separate piece of yarn (about 12 inches long).
- Wrap it tightly around the middle of the pom pom maker, in the groove where you just cut the yarn.
- Pull it as tight as possible and tie a double knot to secure it.

7. Remove the Pom Pom Maker

- Gently pull apart the pom pom maker and remove your pom pom.
- Fluff it up with your fingers.

8. Trim and Shape

- Use scissors to trim any uneven strands and shape your pom pom into a perfect ball.

Your knitted pom pom is now ready!
